2. Exhibiter or parent must own the exhibit animal.
3. Exhibitor is limited to (1) one exhibit animal in each youth class.
4. Time for receiving animals will be Saturday, September 30, 9am-4pm and Monday 9am-2pm.
5. All animals must be in good health.
6. Animals will be kept in clean pens with clean water, fed with hay and feed and managed by the animal committee.
7. Animals can be picked up on Sunday, November 5th, 9am-5pm.
8. Animals will be judged and awarded 1st Place Blue Ribbon- \$10.00, 2nd and 3rd Place will receive ribbons only.

YOUTH PHOTOGRAPHY

1. The term "Print" is the same as photograph or enlargement.
2. All photographs must have been taken by the exhibitor within the last 18 months.
3. Photographer must have permission of subject (s) to enter photographs of people.
4. Exhibitor is limited to one entry per class.
5. All photographs must be 8 x 10, 8 x 12, or 11 x 14 inches in size. They must be mounted or matted on stiff backing. The overall size of photograph and mount or matte should not exceed 11 x 14 inches. Do not attach hangers to back of mount.
6. Photographs in frames, or contained in any type of glass mount **will not be accepted.**
7. The screening committee and the judges reserve the right to reject any prints not meeting specifications and to eliminate any classification due to insufficient number of entries.
8. The screening committee will arrange the prints according to available space. Any prints not corresponding to a proper category may be eliminated.
9. The Fair will take reasonable care of all prints but in no case will the Fair, judges, or the screening committee be responsible for any damage or loss which might occur.
10. Exhibitor's name and address, phone number, and choice of categories should be listed on the back of each print.
